Florida Residency Requirements for Recipients of First Dose of COVID-19 Vaccine

In accordance with the State of Florida Department of Health Public Health Advisory re: the prioritization of Floridians for COVID-19 vaccinations, individuals presenting for their <u>first</u> dose of the COVID-19 vaccine must be able to demonstrate residency in Florida.

In order to demonstrate Florida residency, an individual must present either

(1) A valid Florida driver license or valid Florida identification card, or

(2) If an individual does not have a valid Florida driver license or identification card, they may present a copy of <u>two</u> of the following items that show proof of residential address:

- A deed, mortgage, monthly mortgage statement, mortgage payment booklet or residential rental or lease agreement. (Copies of deeds can be found on the Clerk of the Circuit Court and County Comptroller website <u>https://www.sarasotaclerk.com/</u>)
- A utility hookup or work order that is not more than 2 months old.
- A utility bill that is not more than 2 months old.
- Mail from a bank or other financial institution, including checking, savings, or investment account statements, that is not more than 2 months old.
- Mail from a government agency that is not more than 2 months old. (Mail from a government agency can include tax bills showing a Florida address. Tax bills can be found on the Sarasota County Tax Collector website <u>https://www.sarasotataxcollector.com/</u>)
- One of the above items from the individual's parent, step-parent, legal guardian or other person with whom the individual resides <u>and</u> a statement from the parent, step-parent, legal guardian or other person with whom the person resides stating that the person does resides with him or her.

Please note, the above residency requirements do **<u>NOT</u>** apply to health care providers or individuals presenting for their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.
